**Best job you could have besides current one?** Personal Shopper

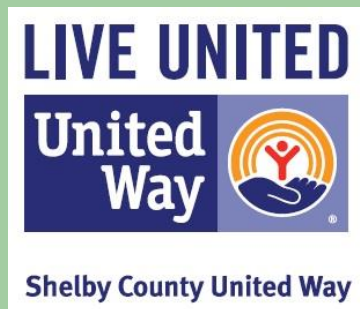
