Meet our Programs and Projects Chair, Mary Beth Monnier:

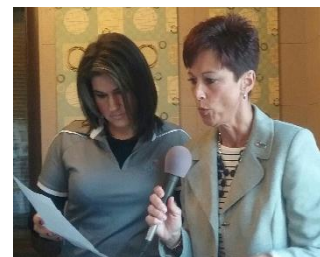
